

Directions to Johannesburg Model Aircraft Club. (JOMAC.)

As a user of Google Maps, type in "JOMAC entrance" and this will take you to the turn off onto the sand road, mentioned in the text below.

If you get lost, phone Jon on 082 450 6580.

From Fourways there are two routes to choose from, either Cedar Road or William Nicol. The most direct is William Nicol, but not the most scenic.

From **Cedar Road**, travelling east along the R 114, Mulderdrift Road, continue past Heron Bridge School for a further 1,6 kilometres. ($25^{\circ} 56' 39''$ S and $25^{\circ} 58' 31''$ E at this point). As you come over the hill, you will see a turning to your right onto a sand road, which is denoted by a JOMAC sign, and the back of a "road narrows" triangle, both on the other side of the road. The road runs parallel to the R114, into the valley and across the river.

The buildings of the Northern Farms Food Empowerment Zone are on your right. Notification of this, is displayed on a yellow and white sign board. The JOMAC windsock and thatch roofs are clearly visible, above the farm buildings, at this point.

Keeping right, drive up the hill, and turn right into the trees. Follow the road, which tracks the palisade fence for a further 1,5 kilometres, arriving at JOMAC.

From **William Nicol**, go under the N 14 and turn left onto the R 114, Muldersdrift Road. Continue, and cross back over the N14, at which point there is a turning to your left into Diepsloot.

Continue for a further 4,0 kilometres, through the bottom of the valley and up the other side. ($25^{\circ} 56' 39''$ S and $25^{\circ} 58' 31''$ E at this point). Before the top of the hill, take the turning to you left onto a sand road, which is denoted by a "road narrows" triangle, and a JOMAC sign. Turn through 180 degrees, running back, parallel to the R114, into the valley and across the river.

The buildings of the Northern Farms Food Empowerment Zone are on your right. Notification of this is displayed on a yellow and white sign board. The JOMAC windsock and thatch roofs are clearly visible, above the farm buildings, at this point.

Keeping right, drive up the hill, and turn right into the trees. Follow the road that tracks the palisade fence for a further 1,5 kilometres, arriving at JOMAC.

The GPS co-ordinates of the the New JOMAC are:
25⁰ 56' 86" S and 27⁰ 58' 49" E.
